Dear Friends,

We received formal notification this morning that our K-6 waiver has been approved by the State.

The Board of Trustees has voted unanimously to re-open up to sixth grade for in-person learning on August 31.

If San Diego is able to stay off the watch list for another week, all schools would be eligible to reopen starting September 1, provided health and safety protocols are in place.

If allowed by the State and the County, the Board has voted to re-open seventh and eighth grades at TCS for in-person instruction on Wednesday, September 2. Given the strong possibility that we will be able to re-open seventh and eighth grades mid-week, we are postponing the start date for those two grades to September 2. We will send more information to families as we gain clarity from the County.

As always, we reiterate that this year the option of distance learning will be available to all families at any time.

We are hopeful that the beginning of the school year will mark a return to some degree of normalcy for all of our families, even as we acknowledge that we continue to operate under the constraints imposed by the virus. Our children's long-term stability depends on the ability of the adults who love them to manage this crisis with both prudence and optimism. All of us, faculty and staff, want you and your child to know how much we are looking forward to the magic of this new school year. We've been working hard for this moment, and we really can't wait to see you again!
