

Covid-19 Protocols for In-Studio Classes

The Dance Academy will follow state and county requirements for operating classes.

Students will not be permitted to attend in-person classes until a Covid-19 Waiver has been completed and received. Adults must be vaccinated to attend in person classes.

Please be sure that students arrive on time, dressed in dance attire.

There will be a drop-off only system. Parents are not allowed to remain on campus during class and we ask that all parents please leave promptly after dropping off their child(ren).

Please screen yourself and/or your child for [COVID-19 symptoms](#) before entering campus.

[Masks](#) will be required for teachers, students and parents.

Return-to-Class Protocols

County health guidelines ask that you notify us and keep your child home if s/he has any of the following symptoms:

- Fever
- Cough
- Shortness of breath or difficulty breathing
- Chills
- Fatigue
- Muscle or body aches
- Headache
- Sore throat
- Congestion or runny nose
- Nausea or vomiting
- Diarrhea
- New loss of taste or smell

In accordance with guidance from the San Diego County Office of Education and San Diego County Health and Human Services Agency, your child may return to class after exhibiting one or more of the symptoms set forth above when **one** of the following occurs:

After 10 days have passed from the day your child's symptom(s) first appeared, **AND** your child's symptoms have improved, including no fever (without the use of fever-reducing medications) for the last 24 hours.

With proof of negative PCR COVID viral test, your child may return after 24 hours have passed without fever (without the use of fever-reducing medications) and symptoms have started improving.

[A signed note](#) from a licensed MD, DO, NP, or PA (who manages your child's preexisting condition that causes the symptom(s)) must: (1) confirm the chronic diagnosis (*i.e.*, cites labs, date-of record when diagnosed); (2) include provider's contact information; (3) explain how symptoms are unrelated to COVID-19; and (4) be accompanied by a signed consent ([form](#)) for the school to communicate with the MD, DO, NP, or PA.
